Refractive Surgery Alliance Society

By-Laws

Adopted April 26, 2014 Amended November 19, 2014, April 11, 2016

Purpose

- To create an alliance of refractive surgeons to provide leadership to take refractive surgery forward through education, research, management, patient care and other activities.
- To grow refractive surgery by growing each member's practice.

General Membership

- 1. Open enrollment to physicians meeting the following criteria:
 - a. Demonstrated commitment to refractive surgery
 - b. Board certified or board eligible in ophthalmology
 - c. Expressed interest in refractive surgery
 - d. Good standing in the medical community
- 2. New member applications will be reviewed by the Executive Committee and accepted with a 2/3 vote
- 3. Members shall be required to sign the Conditions of Membership document upon enrollment
- 4. Members may be expelled by action of the Executive Committee upon majority vote, for perceived activities that violate the Conditions of Participation, without recourse.

Structure

- 1. Membership
 - a. General Membership Unlimited enrollment
 - b. Entrepreneur Section Open to business and administrative staff working in the General Member's practice, subject to Executive Committee approval.
- 2. Executive Committee
 - a. Voting Member Composition: 7 members
 - i. Guy M. Kezirian, MD, MBA, FACS, Chairman (permanent Advisor member)
 - ii. Executive Officers:
 - 1. President, Vice President/President Elect, Secretary, Treasurer.
 - 2. Only General Members shall be eligible to serve as Executive Officers.
 - 3. Terms for Executive Officers shall be 2 calendar years.
 - 4. Specific duties for each office shall be defined by the Executive Committee.
 - iii. Two Ad Hoc Advisors
 - b. Non-Voting Members
 - Heads of the Refractive Surgery Alliance Society Sections, as designated by the Executive Committee

- c. Executive Committee Election Process
 - i. The Chairman is a permanent member of the Executive Committee
 - 1. Succession to the Executive Committee Chairman position shall occur at the discretion of the current Chairman
 - ii. Executive Officers serving on the Executive Committee shall be nominated by the outgoing Executive Committee and confirmed by a simple majority of a quorum vote of the general membership. For purposes of Executive Officer election, a quorum shall be deemed as 50% plus one of the current active General Members in the Refractive Surgery Alliance Society
 - iii. Advisors on the Executive Committee shall be appointed by the Executive Committee Chairman, subject to unanimous approval of the current Executive Committee.

3. Administration

- a. The Executive Committee shall appoint an Administrator and other personnel, as needed, to manage the day to day affairs of the organization
- b. Payment of the Administrator shall occur within a compensation range commensurate to similar organizations
- c. Selection of vendors to the Refractive Surgery Alliance Society shall occur by the Administrator in coordination and subject to approval by the Executive Committee Chairman

Fees

Annual Membership Dues:

Full Membership & Advisors: \$800New Physician Membership: \$100

- Per year after training, for the first 4 years in practice
- At 5 years, members must convert to Full Membership.
- New Physicians may opt for Full Membership at any time.
- o Residents and Fellows: \$50
- Fees are billed in December for the upcoming year
- Dues for new members who join after July 1 of each year shall apply through the following year.
- Fees may be modified per the discretion of the Executive Committee

Permitted use of membership fees

- Support for meetings (venue, food, AV, etc.)
- Payment to vendors
- Administrative expenses (administrative, accounting, legal, etc.)

Activities

- Bi-annual meetings at ASCRS, AAO
- Meeting at practices
- Online email forum
- Ad hoc committees, sections, and activities

Services

The Refractive Surgery Alliance Society will:

- Provide a private Members-Only email Forum
- Maintain the Refractive Surgery Alliance Society web page
- Manage Society funds
- Provide financial reports to the members.

Fees paid for these services shall be within a range commensurate to similar organizations

Ownership

The Refractive Surgery Alliance Society is a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Refractive Surgery Alliance, Inc., a for-profit Delaware corporation. The Refractive Surgery Alliance Society shall be run on a break-even basis as much as is practicable. Management control shall be under the Founder, Guy M. Kezirian, MD, MBA, FACS. Operational control shall occur in coordination with the Executive Committee.
